
Facts about **Domestic Violence**

1 in 3 & 1 in 4 women

have experienced rape, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner in their lifetime.





1 in 2

have experienced psychological aggression by an intimate partner in their lifetime.




1 in 4 & 1 in 7

severe physical violence includes hit with a fist or something hard, beaten, burned or choked

Lesbian women, bisexual women, and bisexual men experience significantly

higher rates of intimate partner violence.







Most victims experienced some form of intimate partner violence before their
